Frequently Asked Questions

Q1. What is the purpose/primary focus of the church-wide series?

The primary objectives of the series are to "Raise and Equip Followers of Christ" and to "Love People". The strategy we've employed is to go through a journey on truth and love by using the Daniel Dilemma church wide series. This will be reflected in our Big Church services, Life Groups, FUSE Youth and Kids' Church. The series helps us learn to stand firm in God's truth and love well with God's love in the culture we live in. We will look to Jesus and Daniel as our examples.

Q2. How long does the church-wide series go for?

The series goes for 7 weeks from 30th April with the last week being a celebration within your group. We encourage everyone to commit to this period.

Q3. How do I take part in this church-wide series?

1. Attend 6 weekend services.
2. Participate in 7 weekly Life Groups to watch the teaching videos and go through the study guides. If you are not in a life group then we invite you to start up or sign up.
3. If you are a parent of school aged children, I invite you to bring your kids to Kids' Church and/or FUSE Youth as they will be running the series as well.

Q4. Is this something I can bring my friends to?

Yes, you can! This church wide series will have a powerful impact on both enquirers into the faith and believers alike. The fundamental question of the church wide series, "How can I stand firm and love well in a culture of compromise?" is an ideal starting point for enquirers.

Q5. Is there a cost to the church-wide?

The participant study guides cost \$15 and is available at the desk.

Q6. Can participants share a study guide?

Part of what makes this series effective is the journaling component. It is strongly encouraged that every participant has their own study guide. Personal thoughts between yourself and God can then be recorded privately. \$15 is a minor investment that has major implications to your spiritual growth and maturity.

Q7. Why Celebrate?

It's a major milestone to listen to sermons, meet for 6 weeks and perform the in between exercises. And we encourage you to celebrate this achievement via a meal with your life group on the 7th week. No video studies to watch or study guides to follow. Simply enjoy the fun, friendship, and fellowship of one another.

Q8. How do I join or host a life group?

Scan the QR code (or enter the web address), fill out the appropriate form, submit and we'll be in touch.



Q9. What's next after the church-wide series?

All life groups are encouraged to keep going and to continue growing in community after the church wide series. However, if you feel that you can't continue within the life group and/or would like to join another life group then that's ok too.
