Little children learn best by example, so it really helps if parents join in – sitting on the mat with them if necessary. Chatting during singing time is very distracting for children and leaders, so please don't!



## Birthdays & Celebrations

We give each child a small gift and sing to celebrate their birthday. Some members of our playgroup community are Christian and we are always glad to answer questions about our faith. If you'd like to receive information about service times etc, please ask Sue or another leader. We also celebrate Easter and Christmas, and talk about the Christian message of these celebrations.

## Concerns & Respect

If you have concerns about behaviour or discipline within your group, please speak to Sue and we will attempt to resolve the situation. Although we all have different expectations of our children, we do expect courtesy and respect for others from all children and adults at playgroup.

## Extreme Heat / Fire Danger

We close playgroup on days where the forecast is 38 degrees and above, and also on days where a code red/catastrophic warning has been issued.

A number of schools/kinders in the local area are closed on these days, and we have decided that it is unsafe for our families to be attending playgroup in such conditions.

We endeavour to contact families by SMS if playgroup is closed for the day, but you are welcome to contact Sue if you are unsure.
